- 2. The first application of the applicant was rejected on 08/03/2006. However, liberty was granted to the applicant to apply for bail again if the trial is not over within a period of six months. The applicant was arrested on 05/08/2005 and is in jail since then. The other co-accused have been released on bail after the application of the applicant was rejected by this Court. Trial is not likely to commence in the near future. Applicant has a fixed place of

residence. Admittedly, there are no criminal antecedents against the present applicant. Under these circumstances, in my view, the applicant is liable to be released on bail.

- 3. Applicant be released on bail in the sum of Rs 5000/- with two local sureties in the like amount. He shall attend Kalamboli Police Station twice in a month. The applicant shall not threaten the witnesses or tamper with the evidence.
- 4. Application is disposed of in the above terms.
