. By the present application what is sought
for is the transit anticipatory bail. The
applicant is the resident of Kandivali, Mumbai and
he carries on business of distributing various
State organised lotteries including the Arunachal
Pradesh State Lottery. The applicant being
distributor of the Arunachal Pradesh State
Lottery, has appointed sub-distributor and
sub-stockist for the purposes of distribution of
lottery tickets. An offence has been registered
against the applicant and his stockits at
Adityapura Police Station, Sarai Kela, Kharsava,
State of Jharkhand. Applicant being a permanent
resident of Mumbai has moved this application as
he apprehends that the Adityapura police station

through Mumbai police may arrest the applicant for commission of offence under section 420 of the I.P.C. and section 11 of the Bengal Public Gambling Act in C.R. No. 277 of 2006. By an ad-interim order, I direct that in the event if applicant is arrested for commission of offences referred to above, by respondents he shall be released on bail on furnishing a bond in the sum of Rs. 25,000/- with two sureties in the like amount. This order shall operate for a period of 3 weeks from today, during which period the applicant shall approach the appropriate Court in Sarai Kela, Kharsava, State of Jharkhand and seek necessary orders.
