to Crime No.55 of 2006 on the file of Somarasampettai Police Station, Trichy, and that the second detenu by name Baskar was also arrested on the same date in respect of Crime No.56 of 2005 on the file of the said Police Station. He further states that both of them were produced before the Judicial Magistrate, Trichy, on 13.02.2006 and that they were remanded to judicial custody on the orders of the learned Magistrate.

2. In the light of the above information, no further adjudication is required in this Habeas Corpus Petition. Accordingly, the same is dismissed.
