Oral order:

The 1st petitioner's husband, who was working with the respondents-APSRTC was terminated from service. The Labour Court, by award dated 29.01.1999, set aside the order of termination, and directed his reinstatement into service. During the pendency of the proceedings before the Labour Court, he died on 09.02.1996.

Pursuant to the award of the Labour Court, the 1st petitioner made representation dated 05.06.2002 followed by another representation dated 14.06.2005, to the respondents seeking employment to the 2nd petitioner on compassionate grounds under the Bread Winner Scheme, but till date no orders thereon have been passed.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Standing Counsel for the respondents-APSRTC, and having regard to the fact that the representation dated 14.06.2005 made by the 1st petitioner seeking employment to the 2nd petitioner on compassionate grounds under the Bread Winner Scheme is pending, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition with the following directions:

The respondents are directed to consider and dispose of the representation dated 14.06.2005, said to have been made by the 1st petitioner seeking employment to the 2nd petitioner on compassionate grounds under the Bread Winner Scheme, expeditiously, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of with the above

directions. No costs.
