**ORDER** (Per the Hon'ble Sri Justice L.Narasimha Reddy):

Petitioner preferred an appeal, along with an application for stay, before the third

respondent aggrieved by an order of assessment, dated 22-03-2005, passed by the

second respondent. The third respondent rejected the stay. Thereupon, he filed a

revision before the fourth respondent. It was dismissed on 10-05-2006. Hence, this

writ petition.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Special Government

Pleader for Commercial Taxes.

The petitioner availed the statutory remedy of appeal before the third respondent

and also filed an application for stay as required under the Andhra Pradesh General

Sales Tax Act, 1957. The petitioner states that he has made deposits, as condition

precedent, for presenting the appeal. If the petitioner is required to deposit the entire

disputed amount, the appeal becomes nugatory.

Hence, the writ petition is disposed of directing that there shall be stay of

further proceedings, pursuant to the order of assessment passed by the second

respondent, till the disposal of the appeal by the third respondent, on condition that

the petitioner deposits half of the disputed amount, within a period of six weeks from

today. The deposits, if any, made by the petitioner, including the one as condition

precedent for presenting the appeal, shall be taken into account for this purpose.

There shall be no order as to costs.
