This petition is directed against order dated 16-05-2006 passed by the Appellate Authority constituted under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 insofar as it permits respondent No.1 to continue to operate for a period of three months.

At the hearing, learned counsel for respondent No.1 made a statement that his client has closed the industry.

Sri S.V. Bhatt, counsel appearing for the petitioner does not dispute this statement.

In view of the above, the writ petition is disposed of as infructuous. However, it is made clear that if respondent No.1 restarts the industry, the Board shall be obliged to file petition for initiation of proceedings under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 and also for launching prosecution of the management of respondent No.1.

As a sequel to disposal of the writ petition, WPMP No.14134 of 2006 filed by the petitioner for staying the operation of the order under challenge is disposed of as infructuous.
