**O R D E R:**

- This writ petition is filed seeking a declaration that the proceedings of the second respondent-Mandal Revenue Officer, Dowlaishwaram, dated 05-06-1996, is arbitrary and illegal.

I have heard the learned counsel for both the parties and perused the material on record.

Under the impugned proceedings, dated 05-06-1996, the order of the Revenue Divisional Officer, Rajahmundry, dated 03-06-1996, was revised and temporary permission was granted to the respondents 3 to 6 herein for cultivation of small extents of land specified thereunder.

Though, various grounds have been raised by the petitioner, when the matter is taken up for consideration, it is brought to my notice that one of the assignees under the impugned proceeding dated 05-06-1996 filed W.P.No.23383 of 1996 challenging the very same order and this Court disposed of the writ petition by order dated 06-03-2000 with a direction to the Revenue Divisional Officer to conduct an enquiry after giving notice to the parties within a period of four weeks. This Court has also made it clear that till the enquiry is completed the parties shall maintain *status quo*.

Since the petitioner herein also stands on the same footing, the writ petition is disposed of in terms of the order in W.P.No.23383 of 1996 directing the Revenue Divisional Officer to complete the enquiry, if not already completed, after affording an opportunity to the petitioner herein. No costs.
