## HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE V. ESWARAIAH WRIT PETITION No. 9143 of 2006 **ORDER:**

This petition is filed by the petitioners seeking a writ of mandamus to direct the

respondents to implement the judgment dated 06-02-2004 passed by the

learned Chief Judge, City Small Causes Court, Hyderabad in M.A.No.120 of

2001 by disposing their representation dated 19-06-2004.

The case of the petitioners is that the first petitioner is the owner of the

property bearing H.No.3-2-258 to 260, locality No.226, situated at

Somasundaram Street, Secunderabad, and second petitioner is the owner of a

part of the said property, under registered sale deeds, dated 15-05-1982. The

second respondent issued a demand notice dated 27-06-2001 to the petitioners

demanding to pay the property tax from 1-4-1985 to 31-3-2001, amounting to

Rs.1,47,390 /-. Against the said demand notice, the petitioners filed M.A.No.

120 of 2001 on the file of the Chief Judge, City Small Causes Court, Hyderabad

and the same was allowed holding that the respondent Corporation was entitled

to recover the tax for three years preceding on the date of demand notice.

While so, the petitioners made a representation dated 19-06-2004 before the

second respondent, but the same has not been considered and disposed of.

Hence, the writ petition.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the second

respondent is directed to consider and dispose of the representation of the

petitioners dated 19-06-2004 in accordance with law, within six weeks from the

date of receipt of a copy of this order.

The Writ Petition is accordingly disposed of. No order as to costs.
