ORAL ORDER:

In view of the interim order passed on 5-12-2000 in W.P.M.P. No.35715 of 1998, no further orders are necessary to be passed in the Writ Petition. However, the respondents are directed to implement the said interim order, if not already implemented, forthwith.

Further, in the counter affidavit filed on behalf of the respondents, it is stated *inter alia* that about 450 applications received from the displaced persons under K.R.Dam are under consideration and the petitioner is one among them. The genesis of their claim, date of displacement and other particulars are under verification and as soon as the verification report is received, the Selection Committee headed by the District Collector, as constituted under G.O.Ms.No.266, dated 19-9-1994 will be convened and the Selection Committee has to prepare the seniority list of eligible persons as per actual date of displacement and the list will be sent for approval to the Government as per G.O.Ms.No.44, Irrigation and Command Area Development (P.W.) Department, dated 31-3-1999. Once the list is approved by the Government, the petitioner, if found eligible, would be considered for employment based on his turn, as per the list, in the order of seniority and availability of vacancies in Telugu Ganga Project Circle, Nellore.

In view of the above assertion in the counter, the respondents are directed to consider the case of the petitioner for employment as assured by them, after considering his case for placing him in

With the above directions, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No order as to costs.
