## Hon'ble M.M. Ghildiyal, J

Heard Sri B.P. Nautiyal, learned counsel for the petitioners, learned standing counsel for respondent nos. 1 to 3 and Sri Ramji Srivastava, learned counsel for respondents no. 4.

The dispute relates to the appointment of Shiksha Mitra in Primary School, Kandoibharam, Block- Chakrata, District-Dehradun. In pursuance to the advertisement dated 01.10.2005 proceedings were started for making appointment on the post of Shiksha Mitra. It is specifically mentioned in the advertisement dated 01.10.2005 that appointment so made shall continue till 31<sup>st</sup> May of the year (i.e. end of Academic Session)

Since no appointment order has been issued to either of the parties, respondents may take fresh initiation for making appointment on the post of Shiksha Mitra for current academic session in accordance with Rules, in case, respondents still required Shiksha Mitra in the Institution and the dept. permission to make such appointment.

In view of the above, writ petition is dismissed as infructuous.
