## Hon'ble Rajesh Tandon, J.

Heard the learned counsel for the parties at length.

By the present writ petition the petitioner has prayed for a writ of certiorari quashing the order dated 22.6.2005 and 20.8.2005. Further prayer was made for a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for appointment under compassionate ground.

Briefly stated according to the petitioner his father late Sri Heera Ballabh was posted as Labour (Sharmik) in the Forest Department, Dakshini Van Prabhag, Pithoragarh and he died on 25.6.1994. He behind the petitioner and his mother. The family of the deceased is suffering financial crises after the death of sole bread winner. The petitioner submitted

representation to the respondents for employment but they

rejected the application of the petitioner on the ground that

Government has banned the appointment of labourers in the

Forest Department.

In view of the above, liberty is given to the petitioner to

prefer a fresh representation to the respondents within a month

after obtaining the certified copy of this order. The respondents

directed to decide the representation afresh if the are

petitioner's claim covers under Rule 5 of Recruitment of

Dependants of Government Servants Dying in Harness Rules,

within six weeks thereafter.

Subject to the observations made above, the writ petition

is disposed of. No order as to costs.
