Hon'ble B.C. Kandpal, J. Hon'ble P.C. Pant, J.

Heard Sri S.S. Chaudhary, learned counsel for the petitioner, Sri H.C. Pathak, learned counsel for the respondent No.6, learned G.A. for the State and perused the record.

Learned G.A. makes a statement that the chargesheet has been filed against the petitioner in this case.

In view of the above statement made by learned G.A., this writ petition for quashing the F.I.R. dated 06.04.2006 in Case Crime No. 134 of 2006 under Section 420 I.P.C. has become infructuous.

Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed being infructuous.

Interim stay order dated 16.06.2006 passed by this Court stands vacated.
