By means of this writ petition, the petitioners have sought writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the F.I.R. dated 15.01.2006 (Annexure-1 to the writ petition) relating to Crime No. 16/06 under Section 307, 452, 504 and 506 I.P.C. at Police Station Manglour, District Haridwar.

The petitioners have further sought stay of their arrest. Perusal of the F.I.R. discloses that specific role have been assigned to each of the petitioners that they have fired with fire-arm and there are injuries on the person of the complainant. In the circumstances, it is not a fit case in which this Court should interfere under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

The writ petition is dismissed in limine. However, if the petitioners surrender, their bail application shall be heard by the Court concerned without unreasonable delay.

The stay application as well as urgency applications are disposed of accordingly.
