By means of this writ petition, the petitioner has sought the quashing of the F.I.R. relating to Crime No. 348 of 2005 under Section 420 I.P.C. at Police Station Lansdown, District Pauri Garhwal.

It is alleged in the F.I.R. that the petitioner extracted bribe illegally from the Forest Society in the name of the audit fees while he had submitted his bills to the Department. The allegations are specific in nature and the money has been extracted from as many as nine Forest Societies.

In the circumstances, it is not a fit case to interfere under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. Therefore, the petition is dismissed in limine. However, if the petitioner surrenders, the concerned Courts is directed to dispose of his bail application as expeditiously as possible.

The petition as well as urgency application and criminal misc. application stand disposed of.
