- 3. The petitioner No. 1, who was engaged as Gardner and petitioner No.2, who was engaged as Sweeper (On contract basis), by the Revenue Department, have sought their regularization in service.
- 4. In view of the principle of law laid down in Secretary, State of Karnataka Vs. Uma Devi, reported in (2006) 4 Supreme Court Cases, Pg. 01, wherein it has been held that the workers on daily wages or the persons who get employed without undergoing regular selection process, should not be permitted to be absorbed or regularised against the constitutional scheme of public employment, this Court is not

inclined to issue direction to regularize services of the petitioners as such, the petition is liable to be dismissed.

4. The writ petition is dismissed. Interim order dated 10.05.2006, stands hereby vacated. (All pending applications also stand disposed of).
