Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the mediation was successful and the parties have entered into an amicable settlement of the dispute. He has placed before this court the original record of the mediation wherein the settlement has been recorded by the Mediation Cell, Tis Hazari Courts on the 18th of March, 2006.

As per the settlement, the respondent/workman has agreed to receive an amount of Rs. 33,000/- in full and final settlement of his entire claims and disputes in the industrial adjudication and otherwise. The respondent/workman who is present in court affirms that he has entered into this settlement and that upon receipt of the total amount of Rs. 33,000/- he has no further claims against the petitioner-management including that of reinstatement or on any other count including any monetary claims against the petitioner. In terms of the settlement, workman has been paid a sum of Rs. 28,000/- in cash in court and the parties have agreed that the balance amount of Rs. 5,000/- which is

lying deposited in this court and shall be released by the registry towards the settlement account.


The registry is directed to release the sum of Rs. 5,000/- to the workman in terms of the settlement dated 18th March, 2006. 

The parties state that in view of the settlement between them, nothing further survives for adjudication and the writ petition may be disposed of in terms of the settlement.

In this view of the matter, the writ petition is disposed of in terms of the settlement and the entire claims and disputes of the respondent/workman including that of reinstatement stand settled.

A report dated 20th March, 2006 has been received from the Office of the District and Sessions Judge, Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi placing before this court the entire record. Perusal of the report dated 20th March, 2006 shows that efforts have been put in by the Mediation Cell, Tis Hazari Courts. This court records its appreciation for the manner in which the mediation has been conducted resulting in the successful resolution of the dispute. Copy of this order may be communicated to the Mediation Cell through District and Sessions Judge, Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi.
