

This application has been filed by the Decree holder praying that the decretal amount of Rs.17,55,395/- deposited by the Judgment Debtor in this Court be placed in a Fixed Deposit. From the application, it is appears that the objections under Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act have been filed by the Judgment Debtor, which is registered as OMP No. 250/2006.
