Instant petition has been filed against the order Ann.4 dt.29th March, 2006 passed by the Central Government Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court, Jaipur on an application filed by the petitioner-workman for summoning the original documents in relation to dispute in question.

The petitioner-workman herein after holding departmental inquiry was removed from service and the appropriate government has finally referred the matter for adjudication to the Tribunal. After the evidence of both the parties was closed, application has been filed by the petitioner for summoning the original documents i.e. cheque and pay in slip from the custody of respondent which was opposed by the respondent Bank.

The Tribunal after taking into consideration material, recorded a finding that if original documents have not been placed by the respondent despite request made, he can make all submissions in question and so also discussion of evidence during the course of final hearing of the matter.

Petitioner has filed an application for summoning of the original documents and the respondent has failed to furnish despite request made by him.

I have gone through the finding recorded by the Tribunal and I do not find any error in the finding recorded which is duly supported by material on record.

Consequently, the writ petition fails and is hereby dismissed.
