issued along with the notice of the application
under Section 5 of Limitation Act.

We are of the opinion that on undisputed
facts, questions raised in this petition are
fully governed by the decision of this Court in
relation to grant of selection grades to the
incumbent on completion of 9, 18 and 27 years of
service by which it has been held that period of
9, 18 and 27 years has to be computed with effect

from initial date of appointment including therein the services rendered as ad hoc or temporary appointment as permissible under the Rules.

We do not find any merit in this appeal as the judgment of learned single is in consonance with the aforesaid Full Bench decision of this Court rendered in State of Rajasthan and others Vs. Farooq Ahmed & 59 others reported reported in **2005(1)WLC page 1.**

Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed.
