

S.B.CRIMINAL LEAVE TO APPEAL NO. 154/2006

(State of Rajasthan vs. Salman Khan & Ors.)

Heard learned Public Prosecutor for the State. Perused the judgment and order of acquittal as also the record.

Having considered the totality of facts and circumstances of the case, I think it a fit case to grant leave to appeal to this Court.

Accordingly, the leave to appeal against accused-respondent No.1 Salman Khan against his acquittal for the offences under sections 143, 144, 148, 201 read with section 149 I.P.C. and section 27 of the Arms Act as against accused-respondent No.2 Mohammed Hussain against his acquittal for the offence under section 201 I.P.C. and section 51 of Wild Life (Protection) Act, respondents No.3 Kuldeep alias Papsa No.6 Mahendrapal Singh & Raju Banna, No.7 Mahendra Singh and No.8 Satish Ravi Lal Shah for the offences under sections 143, 201 read with section 149 and 148 I.P.C. and section 51 of Wild

Life (Protection) Act, respondent No.4 Dushyant Singh for the offence under section 201 I.P.C and section 51, 39(B)(B) read with section 51 of Wild Life (Protection) Act and No.5 Yashpal Singh for the offences under sections 143, 148, 201 read with section 149 and section 51,39 (B)(B) read with section 51 of Wild Life (Protection) Act to this Court is granted. The memo of leave to appeal be treated as memo of appeal. Let the appeal be registered on regular number.

Appeal admitted.
