There is no allegation in the writ that the rates were inordinately low or that the writ petitioner was prepared to supply the uniforms at a lower price and they were kept unreasonably excluded. The chosen contractor had supplied previously also. Most importantly all the uniforms have already been supplied and whole matter is one year stale.
