Heard learned counsel for the parties including the learned Sate Counsel appearing for the official Respondents.

Taking into account the issue raised in this writ petition and a s agreed to by the learned counsel for the parities, this writ petition stands c losed today itself at the motion stage with a direction that Respondent No.4, the Chief Conservator of Forests (Territorial), Assam, Kacharighat, Guwahati- 791 001 shall consider and dispose of the representation dated 18.5.2007 presented by the petitioner before the Respondent No.6, the Divisional Forest Officer, C achar Division, Silchar, a copy of which is stated to have been submitted before the aforesaid competent authority, in accordance with law as early as possible preferably within a period of 30 (thirty) days from today.

Petitioners shall be at liberty to furnish the certified copy of this order alognwith the copy of the writ petition with all the annexures appended thereto before the competent authority to do the needful.

Till the disposal of the representation within the time frame as indicated above, the respondents shall not pass any final order pursuant to the NIT dated 16.5.2007 without prior permission of this Court.

This disposes of the writ petition.
