This writ petition has been filed making a grievance against Annexure-D series notices dated 21/22.1.2007 by which the petitioners were asked to vacate the land mentioned in the scheduled thereto. The petitioners were given liberty to produce the documents in support of their claim for occupation of their land.

Mr. N.K. Baruah, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioners have submitted their documents before the authority, which has issued the Annexure-D notices. He further submits that no final order having been passed, the petitioners cannot be evicted on the basis of the impugned notices.

Ms. R. Chakraborty, learned State Counsel, submits that the writ petition is pre-matured. She submits that if the petitioners have been able to produce all the documents in support of their claim of possession of their land, the authority, which has issued the impugned notices, shall examine the same and pass an appropriate order.

In view of the above, I dispose of the writ petition at the motion stage itself providing that the SDO (Sadar), Dibrugarh, who has issued the impugned notices shall pass final order on the basis of the impugned notices dated 21/22.1.2007 taking into account the documents, if any, submitted by the petitioner.

Till passing of final order, the petitioner may not be disturbed.

Writ petition is disposed of.
