HIGH COURT OF CHHATTISGARH AT BILASPUR

ORDER

(Passed on 31st day of October, 2007)

1. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that this Court, while issuing notice on 14.05.2001, directed to maintain status quo as regard the construction of any structure in respect of shop No. 11 and 12, Civic Centre, Bhilai. Thereafter, the respondent No. 1 and 2 have not taken any steps.
2. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner be permitted to make a representation to the competent authority of the respondent No. 1 and 2 for allotment of additional space in the shop No. 11, which may be considered and decided in accordance with law. It is next submitted that the protection granted by this Court on 14.05.2001 should continue till the



disposal of his representation, to which the learned counsel appearing for the respondent No. 1 and 2 has no objection.

3. In view of the foregoing, the petitioner is permitted to make a representation within a period of one week. The same shall be considered and decided as expeditiously as possible, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of two weeks, as requested by the learned counsel for the respondent No. 1 and 2. Interim protection granted by this Court on 14.05.2001 shall continue for a period of three weeks from today.
4. In view of the above, this petition stands disposed of. No order as to costs.
