## ORAL ORDER (31.10.2007)

## SUNIL KUMAR SINHA, J.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a permanent Gang-man is to be retired at the age of 62 years in accordance with the Chhattisgarh Shaskiya Sevak (Adhivarshiki-Ayu) Adhiniyam 1967 read with Fundamental Rules, 56. He also submits that the point raised has been decided by this Court in batch of matters i.e. W.P. No.108/2005 and many other connected matters on 04.01.2007, reported in 2007 (2) C.G.L.J. 29 (Govind & Others vs. State of C.G. and others) and this matter is squarely covered by that decision, which may be disposed of on the same terms.



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Learned counsel for the State fairly agrees that this matter is covered by the said decision. However, he submits that in some matters the State has filed writ appeals.

Unless some interim order is passed, merely on account of filing of the writ appeal, hearing of this writ petition cannot be kept in abeyance, when the matter is squarely covered by the said judgment.

In the result, this petition is allowed.

It is disposed of in terms of the order dated 04.01.2007 passed in W.P. No.108/2005 and other connected matters. No order as to cost.
