ORDER

(Passed on this 30th day of March, 2007)

1. The petitioner has filed this petition challenging the transfer order dated 22.9.2001. By virtue of the interim stay granted by the Madhya Pradesh Administrative Tribunal at Raipur the petitioner is continuing at the original place of posting.
2. Be that as it may, with the passage of time this petition has become infructuous as period of transfer is not applicable forever. At this point of time there is no question to examine the validity of the transfer order.
