ORDER

(Passed on 31st January, 2007)

The petitioner's mother namely Smt. Pushpa Chaturvedi died while working as Assistant Teacher in Adarsh Prathamik Shala, Kharsia on 06-08-1998.

2. Thereafter, the petitioner has made an application for compassionate appointment on 08-07-1999 (Annexure A/2). The application of the petitioner for compassionate appointment has not been decided by the respondents-Authorities.

3. The Government of Chhattisgarh, by its circular dated 02-02-2006, has directed all the departments to consider cases of all the eligible dependant legal heir of the deceased employees, who died in harness between 01-11-1997 to 31-10-2000 for compassionate appointment.

4. Accordingly, the Government of Chhattisgarh is directed to consider the case of the petitioner as per its own circular dated 02-02-2006 and also in view of the order passed by this Court in Writ Petition No. 3879 of 2004 and other connected matters, on its own merit, in accordance with

law, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. For the reasons above-stated, the writ petition stands disposed of.
