

None appears for the respondents.

Heard on application (P.R. No. 1392/2007) i.e. an application for amendment in the memo of writ appeal.

On 4-10-2006 final order has been passed by learned single Judge in W.P., No. 5245/2006. Learned single Judge dismissed the petition on merit. The petitioner instead of preferring writ appeal filed an application for review bearing No. 25/2006 before him. Learned Single Judge heard it and vide order dated 7-11-2006 dismissed the review petition.

The petitioner filed the writ appeal against the order dated 7-11-2006 passed by the learned Single Judge in review petition No. 25/2006. By proposed amendment, petitioner intends to delete and incorporate materials which will substantially change the nature of memo of appeal.

Once the petitioner foregoes his statutory right of appeal and in place of preferring appeal, he chooses to move application for review and when his application for review has been rejected he cannot come back to assail the original order by preferring appeal against it. Therefore, the amendment proposed by the petitioner which substantially changes

the nature of appeal itself can't be permitted to be incorporated in the memo accordingly the application for amendment in the writ appeal is dismissed.

The High Court of Chhattisgarh Rules, 2005 only provides appeal against the judgment or final order passed by one judge of the High Court in exercise of original jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, therefore, appeal against rejection of review petition is not maintainable. Presently there is no appeal against the order dated 4-10-2006 passed in W.P. No. 5245/2006 by the learned Single Judge, therefore the question of condonation of delay in filing the appeal does not arise.

As a result of rejection of application for amendment filed by the petitioner, the application for condonation of delay (P.R. No. 1393/2007) becomes redundant and the instant appeal instituted against the order passed by learned Single Judge exercising review jurisdiction being not appealable, is not maintainable.

Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed.
