The learned counsel for the plaintiff submits that in view of the arbitration clause in the agreement, on the basis of which suit has been filed, the plaintiff will resort to invocation of the arbitration clause and invoke the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 for getting the interim reliefs. Therefore, he may be permitted to withdraw the suit with liberty to seek arbitration and interim relief.
