Heard Shri Abbasi, learned counsel
for the applicant – appellant and Shri Kakade,
learned AGP for the respondent.

First Appeal No. 368 of 2007 came to
be dismissed for not supplying the English
translations and the learned counsel states
that the translations are now ready with him.
The learned counsel contends that as
dismissal was noticed belatedly, there is
delay of 13 days.

AGP opposes the request. However,
in the interest of justice, delay of 13 days is
condoned subject to applicant's making
payment of cost of Rs.500/- to the High Court
Legal Services Sub-Committee, Nagpur,

within a period of two weeks from today.

If the costs are so paid, the delay shall stand condoned and in that event MCA St. No. 10947 of 2007 shall also stand allowed.

The applicant/ appellant shall remove the objections within one week thereafter.

Accordingly, applications are disposed of.
