He has placed on record various documents to show that the University has been treating him as Teacher and passing various orders in his favour. Petitioner, however, is aggrieved of the order dated 11th June, 2004 whereby the petitioner's appeal/request for continuation of petitioner's name in the Electoral Roll for Election to the Junior Teacher Constituency has been rejected. perusal of the order, it is clear that no reasons whatsoever

have been assigned while considering and rejecting the

petitioner's request.

Without going into the merits/controversy

respectively raised by the learned counsels, the respondent is

directed to furnish the reasons of rejection of his

representation within a period of two weeks from today. It

will be open for the petitioner to take all such measures as he

may be advised. Other questions raised in the present

petition remain undecided. It will also open for the parties to

take all such pleas and contentions as may be available to

them, in the event of the petitioner initiating any further

proceedings before an appropriate forum. The present writ

petition is disposed of accordingly.
