JUDGMENT

Koshy, J.

The appellant-petitioner suffered injuries in a motor accident.

The injuries sustained as per Exhibit A68 wound certificate are as

follows:

"1) Deep lacerated wound on the accipital region of

scalp 5 x 3 x 3 cm. 2) Contusion forehead.

3) Contusion right eye-brow, small lacerated wound over it.

4) Linear laceration 1 cm long over the chin."

2. The Tribunal awarded Rs.13,500/- with 9% interest. The

injuries are only contusion and laceration. There is no evidence of

permanent disability. Considering the nature of injuries suffered by

the petitioner, the rate of interest and the total compensation

awarded, we are of the opinion that just and reasonable

compensation was granted and no interference is called. The appeal

is dismissed.
