ORDER:

The vehicle of the petitioner bearing No.AP 02/V 4517 was seized on 14.08.2007, on the ground that the petitioner failed to produce the necessary documents in relation to it. The petitioner challenges the seizure.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Government Pleader for the respondents.

A perusal of the Vehicle Check Report, dated 14.08.2007, issued by the 2nd respondent, discloses that the petitioner did not produce R.C., I.C., F.C. PUC Certificate, permit and proof of payment of tax and Driving Licence. Certain other lapses were also pointed out. The liability of the petitioner in the context of

these observations needs to be established in the proceedings to

be initiated under the relevant provisions of the Motor Vehicles

Act. If the vehicle is detained and kept in the custody of the 2nd

respondent till such proceedings take place, not only the petitioner

would be put to irreparable loss, but also the vehicle would be

exposed to the danger of theft and damage. The interest of the

State can be protected by imposing necessary conditions, while

permitting the petitioner to keep the custody of the vehicle.

For the foregoing reasons, the writ petition is disposed of,

directing that-

the vehicle of the petitioner, bearing No.AP 02/V a)

4517 shall be released, on his depositing a sum of

Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand Only),

issuance of a cheque, if any; and

b) the petitioner shall also furnish an undertaking to

the effect that he shall not alienate the vehicle, till the

proceedings in pursuance of the Check Report are

finalized and that he shall produce the vehicle as and

when required.
