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ORDER: *(per Hon'ble Sri Justice D.S.R.Varma)*

Heard learned Assistant Government Pleader,  
representing learned Advocate General, appearing for the  
respondents.

2. The complaint made in this writ petition, which is  
taken up on the basis of a telegram, dated 26.05.2007, sent  
by one Manupati Nagendramma, resident of Vedullapalli,  
Guntur District, to the Hon'ble the Chief Justice, High Court  
of Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad, is that her grand son by  
name Manupati Venkateswarlu, Son of Peddabbai  
Vedullapalli, was illegally taken into custody by the  
Superintendent of Police, City Crime Station, Guntur and

that she apprehends danger to his life.

3. Upon receipt of notice, issued by this Court, the first respondent-Inspector of Police, City Crime Station, Guntur, filed counter-affidavit, *inter alia*, stating that the alleged detenu was arrayed as accused in many cases on the file of Lalapet Crime Police Station, Pattabhipuram Crime Police Station and Old Guntur Police Station. While so, in connection with a case in Crime No.2 of 2007 of Vedullapalli Police Station registered against him, he was arrested on 06.06.2007 and was produced before the IV Additional Munsif Magistrate, Bapatla, on the same day, who in turn, passed orders remanding the alleged detenu to judicial custody, consequent upon which, at present the alleged detenu is lodged at District Jail, Guntur.

4. In view of the aforesaid facts of the case, we do not see any ground whatsoever to continue the proceedings. The allegations levelled by the petitioner, in the telegram, are found to be not correct and accordingly, the writ petition is liable to be closed.

5. In the result, the writ petition is closed. There shall be no order as to costs.
