The only grievance of the petitioners is that on the written intimation made by them on 10-04-2007, making certain allegations against unofficial respondents alleging that they committed cognizable offence, the Station House Officer, Chagalamarri, has not taken any action.

Whenever any written intimation has been made by the complainant alleging that cognizable offence has been committed and if no crime is registered by the concerned Station House Officer, there is an effective alternative remedy under the code of criminal procedure for filing private complaint under Section 200 Cr.P.C. before the concerned Magistrate

However, the issue raised in this writ petition is squarely covered by the judgment of this Court in W.P.No.21709 of 2005 and batch, dated 06-02-2007.

Following the said judgment, this writ petition is dismissed.

However, it is open for the petitioners to approach concerned Criminal

Court for filing private complaint. There shall be no order as to costs.
