**WRIT PETITION NO.11635 of 2007**

**ORDER:-**

This Writ Petition is filed for a Writ of Mandamus to declare the action of the respondents in not considering representation dated 14-12-2006 submitted by the petitioner for payment of compensation in respect of certain properties alleged to have been acquired by the respondent-authorities and are in possession of the Greater Municipal Corporation of Visakhapatnam (for short "the Corporation").

Heard Sri P.Venugopal, learned counsel for the petitioner, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Land Acquisition for respondents 1 and 3, Sri N.Ranga Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for the Corporation and Smt.V.Preeti Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for Visakhapatnam Urban Development Authority-respondent No.4 (for short "the VUDA").

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that though the petitioner made a representation to the District Collector, Visakhapatnam (1<sup>st</sup> respondent herein) claiming compensation, so far he has not disposed of the said representation. Learned counsel for the respondents submitted that they have no objection if a direction is issued to the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent to dispose of the said representation of the petitioner.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the parties, the Writ Petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to consider and dispose of the petitioner's representation dated 14-12-2006 within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

As a sequel to disposal of the Writ Petition, WPMP No.14470 of 2007 is dismissed as infructuous.
