C.I-1/96 dated 12-3-1997 of respondent No.2 as illegal, arbitrary and discriminatory and consequently to direct the respondents to absorb the petitioners in their respective posts as per the pattern prescribed in proceedings Rc.No.203/D3/63 dated 26-6-1965 of Director of Public Instruction, A.P. Hyderabad or in accordance with G.O.Ms.No.212 Finance and Planning dated 22-4-1994 in the aided vacancy with all consequential benefits.

- 2. While admitting the writ petition, on 23-10-1997, the respondents were directed to consider the cases of the petitioners for absorption in their respective vacant aided posts within a period of six weeks in accordance with the rules, pending further orders.
- 3. Now, the learned counsel for the petitioners states that in pursuance of the interim order dated 23-10-1997, the services of the

petitioners were regularized.

- 4. In view of the above, nothing survives in the writ petition for further adjudication.
