The prayer made in the present petition is to challenge an order passed by the District Judge restraining the petitioner from alienating the property which is in dispute in the present petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in case she is permitted to sell the property, she will mention the facts in the sale deed and the sale would be subject to the decision of the suit. However, this prayer cannot be accepted at this stage.

Keeping in view the fact that the litigation is between the mother and the daughter and the petitioner herein is divorcee, having one minor daughter to take care of, the trial Court be directed to dispose of the suit expeditiously. In the facts and circumstances of the case, this prayer is reasonable and deserves to be accepted so that the dispute in the family is settled early.

Accordingly, without commenting on merits of the order passed by the District Judge, I direct the trial Court to dispose of the suit expeditiously.

The revision petition is disposed of in the manner indicated above.
