Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners had

gone to school merely enquire as to why the son of the petitioner No.2 was

beaten up in the school and it was not a case of trespass. They had not

given any beating to Bikram Singh one of the teachers in the School.

Though the occurrence is of November 28, 2007, the FIR was lodged in the

present case on 5.12.2007. It is an after-thought just to cover up the

incidence by the school. The report of the injuries suffered by Bikram

Singh in the hands of the petitioners is not available though the occurrence

is of November 28, 2007. In the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be

released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer. Petitioners shall

comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal

Procedure.

Petition is disposed of.
