JUDGMENT

M.M. KUMAR, J. (Oral)

Written statement on behalf of the respondent has been filed in the Court today, which we have taken on record and a copy thereof has been furnished to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

The grievance made by the petitioner is that except gratuity his other benefits like leave encashment could not be withheld even if an inquiry is pending as he superannuated on 30.11.2006.

It is conceded position that inquiry in four cases was held and three charge sheets have been filed. However, there is a fourth charge sheet pending against the petitioner where he appears to have been exonerated. But there is a dissenting note issued by the

punishing authority. According to the written statement, the notice in

that regard has been published in the news paper asking the petitioner

to appear before the punishing authority and the petitioner has not

appeared.

The petitioner undertakes through his counsel to appear

before the punishing authority on 8.5.2007 at 10.00 a.m. i.e. the

Managing Director, PUNSUP, S.C.O. No. 36-40, Sector 34-A,

Chandigarh.

In view of the above, we dispose of the writ petition by

directing the respondent to pay all other benefits like leave

encashment etc., except gratuity forthwith and finalise the pending

inquiry proceedings against the petitioner within a period of three

months from today. It is needless to mention that if the petitioner is

not found guilty of any charges by the punishing authority in

pursuance to the dissenting note issued then the withheld gratuity

amount shall also be released within one month from the date of

decision.

The petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
