By means of this writ petition, the petitioner has prayed for the following reliefs:-

- i. Issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus commanding the respondent no. 2 to decide the appeal of the petitioner contained as annexure no. 2 to this petition within a period of one month on merit.
- ii. Any other order, direction which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case, may also be passed,
- iii. Award the cost of petition.

The petitioner who is working as Patwari and at present is posted at Haldwani, district Nainital was served a charge sheet on 10.11.1997. The inquiry initiated against the petitioner was completed and the Competent authority i.e. the

District Magistrate, Nainital passed order of punishment on

23.04.2004 reverting the petitioner to initial pay scale. Against

the punishment order passed by the District Magistrate, the

petitioner has already preferred appeal before the

Commissioner of the Division on 15.06.2004, which is still

pending before him.

Sole prayer in the writ petition is that the Appellate

Authority i.e. the Commissioner, Kumaon Region, Nainital may

be directed to take decision on the appeal of the petitioner

dated 15.06.2004 within the period prescribed by this Court.

The prayer is innocuous.

Consequently, the respondent no. 2 is directed to take

decision on the appeal preferred by the petitioner on 15th June

2004 against the order of punishment awarded by the District

Magistrate on 23rd April 2004, within a period of four weeks

from the date of production of a certified copy of this order.

With this direction, the writ petition is finally disposed of.

No order as to costs.
