Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Standing Counsel for the State.

By means of this petition, the petitioner has challenged the impugned order dated 24.03.2007, whereby the petitioner is transferred to his parent post. Another impugned order dated 27.12.2006, is also challenged, whereby respondent No. 4 is also reinstated on the post of Coordinator, B.R.C. with the rider that departmental enquiry will proceed against him.

None of these orders violated any of the right of the petitioner under any law, which could attract the provision of Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and after going through the papers on record, this Court is of the view that this writ petition is devoid of merits. Accordingly, the same is dismissed in limine.
