Petitioner is a former Block Development Officer who at relevant time was posted at Barsoi some time in the year 2001 – 2002.

A complaint has been filed in the year 2006 making this petitioner and several other persons alleging them in matters of allotment of Indira Awas Yojana based on the complaint of this case namely Abedpur P.S. Case No. 9 of 2006 was instituted.

Though, there are allegations against present petitioner which is borne out from the complaint but keeping in mind that the same relates to the year 2000 – 2001 and there is no cogent explanation why complaint has now come to be filed. In addition, keeping in mind that the petitioner is still a government servant, in the event of his arrest/surrender within four weeks from today, let the petitioner namely, Sanjay Kumar, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of sum of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Katihar in connection with Abedpur P.S. Case No. 9 of 2006 (G.R. No. 449/06) subject to conditions under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

Petitioner is directed to cooperate in the proceedings who shall not abscond from rigors of law.
