Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

Petitioner is an accused in a case for the offences registered under Sections 406 and 409 of the Indian Penal Code.

The allegation against the petitioner is to the effect that while he was working as Nazir in the Anchal Office of Mahnar a sum of Rs. 25,000/- was found to be short. It is further alleged that this petitioner on the oral order of District Magistrate, Vaishali deposited the said money in the saving account of Circle Officer on 30<sup>th</sup> of June 2006.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that first informant report has been lodged after depositing of the said money.

Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that the shortage of money was found when petitioner was Nazir of Anchal Office, Mahnar.

Considering the submissions as made above, it is directed that in the event of arrest or surrender within a period

of six weeks from today, the petitioner above named be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Mahnar P.S. Case No. 112 of 2006 subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
