The petitioners apprehend arrest in a police case under Section 379, 452 of the Penal Code read with Section 3(v) (x) and (xi) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act.

During investigation the allegations have been found false under the Penal Code for a land dispute between the parties, the submission under the latter Act is that as per allegations it took place in the house and courtyard of the informant and not in a public place in a public view.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let petitioners, above named, surrender in the court below within a period of four weeks from today, when they shall be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Madhubani, in connection with Jaynagar P.S.case no. 73 of 2008, corresponding to G.P. No. 727 of 2008 subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
