The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Kishanganj P.S. Case No.205 of 2007 for the alleged offences registered under sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that on perusal of the F.I.R., it would appear that the only allegation is to the effect that on being asked by the Consolidation Officer, the petitioner did not submit any reply where he was working as a Halka Karamchari.

Considering the above, it is directed that the petitioner Tarun Kumar Yadav, in the event of his arrest or surrender in connection with Kishanganj P.S. Case No.205 of 2007, within a period of four weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of

the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kishanganj, in connection with the aforesaid case, on the conditions mentioned in sub-section (2) of section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
