Petitioner's name appears in the statement of the co-accused
Nago Yadav, who named other persons also who were firing at the
police party.

The contention is that there could be many reasons for being
implicated falsely by the co-accused including some personal ill-
will. The second contention is that in the face of the allegation
there was no recovery of any incriminating article from the
possession of the petitioner.

Let petitioner, named above, be released on bail on furnishing
bail bond of Rs.5,000/-(Five thousand) with two sureties of the
like amount each to the satisfaction of the C.J.M. Saharsa, in
connection with Sour Bazar P.S. case no.58 of 2008.
