







The petitioner shall modify the title of the writ petition accordingly.</p> <p>The writ petitioner who appears in person is unable to furnish required information in detail regarding the averments made in the petition. As such, we find it more appropriate if she approaches Sikkim State Legal Services Authority for legal assistance. On the suggestion made by the Court, the writ petitioner has agreed to approach the Sikkim State Legal Services Authority and seeks a month's time for the same.
