WP(C) 5675/2007 BEFORE HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE B.K. SHARMA

Mr. A.M. Majumdar, learned Sr. counsel for the petitioner upon reference to the additional affidavit filed by the petitioner on 08.01.08 enclosing there with the sworn affidavit of Smt. Bhanumati Begum who is the Vice-Chairman, Howly Town Committee (respondent No. 6), submits that since the parties have arrived at a compromise in respect of the no-confidence motion, the writ petition can be disposed of recording the compromise. Smt. Bhanumati Begum is personally present in the Court and she confirms the position. It was she who brought the no-confidence motion.

Since the parties have arrived at a compromise, this writ petition stand s disposed of with a direction that there will be no effect of the no-confidence motion brought by the respondent No. 6. Consequently, the position of Howly Tow n Committee as it stood prior to bringing the no-confidence motion, shall stand restored. The Deputy Commissioner, Barpeta shall now proceed with the matter in accordance with law taking into account the compromise arrived at by and betwee n the parties.

With the above directions, writ petition stands disposed of.
