Health Engineering Deptt. till 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2007. However, his services have been discontinued from 01<sup>st</sup> January, 2008 without any formal order in this regard. In the meanwhile, the State Govt. vide Circular dated 5<sup>th</sup> March, 2008 has decided to regularize the services of the daily wage ad hoc employees, who are appointed between 1.1.1989 and 31.12.1997

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is not pressing this petition at this stage. However, he prays for liberty to make a detailed representation before the competent authority of the respondents to apply for reappointment and regularization in view of Circular dated 5<sup>th</sup> March, 2008, which may be decided on its own merits, in accordance with law.

Shri Ajay Dwivdi, learned Dy GA for the State has no objection if the petition is disposed of with the aforesaid liberty.

In view of above submissions of the parties, the instant petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed representation for reappointment and regularization before the concerned competent authority of the State Govt. On such representation being filed, the same shall be decided on its own merits in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of such representation.
